Activity: CHOCTAW RESPONSES/TRUE OR FALSE/MATCHING -SENTENCE TRANSLATIONS

Students will answer Choctaw questions in written form using the correct pronouns. Students will match Choctaw sentences to English sentences.

Closure: Teacher will ask questions and students will give impromptu answers in Choctaw.
