Lesson 4: Model 3 Sentences

Starter: Students will give the greeting, date, and weather. Students will engage in dialogue with a prepared question and give impromptu responses.

Speaker 1: Ohoyo pisa achukma ish p̄isa tuk o?

Speaker 2: Allow for individual responses.

Objective: Students will learn Model 3 sentences and practice speaking and engaging in Choctaw conversation. Students will complete activities for review and reinforcement of comprehension skills.

Activity: TRANSLATIONS/RESPONSES
