A) Chalaki micha Chahta yut impa. a) The Cherokee and Choctaw are eating.

b) Ish impa tuk <u>o</u>? b) Did you eat?

c) Keyu, sv hohchvffo. c) No, I'm hungry.

d) Binili micha impa! d) Sit and eat!

Activity: TRANSLATIONS/RESPONSES

Sentences will translate sentences to English and respond to questions with written Choctaw responses. Students will give English definitions for Choctaw words.

Closure: Students will ask two Choctaw questions of another student. Students must give responses in Choctaw.
