Chapter 5: Anumpa ᵁh̄toba Ikv̄hlo (Indefinite Pronouns - Part 2)

Lesson 2: Model I Sentences

Starter: Students will give the greeting, date and weather. Students will engage in dialogue with a prepared question and give impromptu responses.

Speaker 1: Towa washoha nanta ish aiokpanchi?

Speaker 2: Allow for individual responses.

Objective: Students will learn Model I sentences and practice speaking and engaging in Choctaw conversation. Students will complete an activity for review and reinforcement of comprehension skills.

Presentation of new material: Model I Sentences

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| a) Holisso m̄ katimma ish bohli tuk? | a) Where did you put that book? |
| b) Kanimma bohli li tuk. | b) I laid it somewhere. |
| c) Kanimma ia chi b̄v̄nna h̄? | c) Do you want to go somewhere? |
| d) Himak nittak ā aiit̄v̄toba ia sv̄ b̄v̄nna. | d) I want to go to the store today. |

Activity: VOCABULARY/MATCHING/TRUE OR FALSE

Students will practice translation of words and sentences, match English sentences to Choctaw sentences, and answer True or False statements.

Closure: Students will pair up and take turns asking questions *a* and *c* from Model I sentences. Encourage students to be creative with their answers.
