Lesson 1: Vocabulary Words and Model I sentences

Speaker 2: Allow for individual responses.

Objective: Students will practice pronunciation by syllables and write the meaning of each vocabulary word. Students will practice Model I questions and responses.

Presentation of new material: Model I sentences

| b) Onnakma t̄vm̄aha il ilhkola ch̄i. | b) We will go to town tomorrow. |
| c) Kanimikma nan vn̄noa ish anola ch̄i h̄o? | c) Will you tell a story sometime? |
| d) <u>A</u> , himak ninak chim anoli la hinla. | d) Yes, I can tell you tonight. |

Activity: PRONUNCIATION/TRANSLATIONS & FILL IN THE BLANKS

Students will practice pronunciation and write the definition of each vocabulary word. Students will complete sentences with correct Choctaw vocabulary word.

Closure: The teacher will say a Choctaw vocabulary word and students will respond with the correct English translation.
