Chapter 6: Anumpa Vlhtoba Ikvhlo (Indefinite Pronouns - Part 3)Lesson 2: Model 2 Sentences

**Starter:** Students will give the greeting, date, and weather. Students will engage in dialogue with a prepared question and give impromptu responses.

Speaker I: Katimikma holisso apisa yvt foha ch<u>i</u>? Speaker 2: Allow for individual responses.

**Objective:** Students will learn Model 2 sentences, practice speaking and engaging in Choctaw conversation. Students will complete an activity for review and reinforcement of comprehension skills.

## Presentation of new material: Model 2 Sentences

- a) Katimikash hattak ma ish apela tuk?
- b) Pilashash hattak m<u>a</u> apela li tuk.
- c) Kanimikash issi nipi ish hoponi tuk <u>o</u>?
- d) <u>A</u>, Satutiash issi nipi hoponi li tuk.
- a) When did you help that man?
- b) I helped that man yesterday.
- c) Did you cook venison sometime ago?
- d) Yes, I cooked venison last Saturday.

## Activity: WORD TRANSLATIONS/MATCHING/TRUE OR FALSE

Students will practice translations of words and sentences, matching English to Choctaw sentences and complete True or False statements.

**Closure:** Each student will write on a slip of paper, a response in Choctaw to the question, "Twmaha ish ia ch<u>i</u> h<u>o</u>"? They will respond to the question in a complete sentence. Answers will vary.

Ex: "Tumaha ia la chi (ia la chi kiyo)".

The teacher will call on students, ask the question, and students will read their answer aloud.

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
