Lesson 3: Model 3 Sentences

Starter: Students will give the greeting, date, and weather. Students will engage in dialogue with a prepared question and give impromptu responses.

Speaker I: Himak ninak <u>a</u> katimma ish ia ch<u>i</u>?

Speaker 2: Allow for individual responses.

Objective: Students will learn Model 3 sentences, practice speaking and engage in Choctaw conversation. Students will complete an activity for review and reinforcement of comprehension skills.

Presentation of new material: Model 3 Sentences

a) Ohoyo mut bahta katohmi shali? a) How many sacks is that woman carrying?

b) Bahta chito kanohmi shali. b) She is carrying several large bags.

c) Ulla put hotina hinla ho? c) Can this child count?

d) Kanimikash \underline{i} shulush hotina tuk. d) She counted her shoes sometime ago.

Activity: DEFINITE/INDEFINITE PRONOUNS/WORD MEANING/SPEAKING SKILLS

Students will translate words and engage in question/answer responses in Choctaw.

Closure: Students will create new questions from Model I, 2, & 3 sentences. Students will read their question and choose another student to respond.
