**Lesson 3:** Model 3 Sentences

Speaker 2: Allow for individual responses.

**Objective:** Students will learn Model 3 sentences, practice speaking and engage in Choctaw conversation. Students will complete an activity for review and reinforcement of comprehension skills.

**Activity:** DEFINITE/INDEFINITE PRONOUNS/WORD MEANING/SPEAKING SKILLS

Students will translate words and engage in question/answer responses in Choctaw.

**Closure:** Students will create new questions from Model 1, 2, & 3 sentences. Students will read their question and choose another student to respond.
