**Lesson 4:** Model 4 Sentences

**Starter:** Students will give the greeting, date, and weather. Students will engage in dialogue with a prepared question and give impromptu responses.

Speaker I: Vlla tek katohmi hosh aboha ma binohmaya?

Speaker 2: Allow for individual responses.

**Objective:** Students will learn Model 4 sentences, practice speaking and engage in Choctaw conversation. Students will complete an activity for review and reinforcement of comprehension skills.

## **Presentation of new material:** Model 4 Sentences

- a) Katimikma chiki yut chukka ula chi? a) When will your dad arrive home?
- b) Kanimikma chukka vla chi. b) (He) will arrive home sometime.
- c) Svntikma vla chi ho? c) Will (he) arrive on Sunday?
- d) Keyu, onnakma vla chi. d) No, (he) will arrive tomorrow.

**Activity:** VOCABULARY/TRANSLATIONS/SENTENCE STRUCTURE Students will write the English meanings for Choctaw words, read Choctaw sentences and choose the correct English translation.

**Closure:** Students will choose a question or statement word "Katimikma" or "Kanimikma" and create a complete sentence. Students will read aloud their question or statement to the class.
