Lesson 4: Model 4 Sentences

Starter: Students will give the greeting, date, and weather. Students will engage in dialogue with a prepared question and give impromptu responses.

Speaker 1: ᵁlla tek katohmi hosh aboha mā binohm̄aya?

Speaker 2: Allow for individual responses.

Objective: Students will learn Model 4 sentences, practice speaking and engage in Choctaw conversation. Students will complete an activity for review and reinforcement of comprehension skills.

Presentation of new material: Model 4 Sentences

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| a) Katimikma ch̄iki yvt chukka v̄la ch̄i? | a) When will your dad arrive home? |
| b) Kanimikma chukka v̄la ch̄i. | b) (He) will arrive home sometime. |
| c) Sv̄ntikma v̄la ch̄i ho? | c) Will (he) arrive on Sunday? |
| d) Keyu, onnakma v̄la ch̄i. | d) No, (he) will arrive tomorrow. |

Activity: VOCABULARY/TRANSLATIONS/SENTENCE STRUCTURE

Students will write the English meanings for Choctaw words, read Choctaw sentences and choose the correct English translation.

Closure: Students will choose a question or statement word “Katimikma” or “Kanimikma” and create a complete sentence. Students will read aloud their question or statement to the class.
