**Lesson 1:** Vocabulary Words

**Presentation of new material:** Vocabulary Words

e/il	we	eho/iloh	we (all)
hvsh	you (all)	they	(unmarked)
peh	just	latvssa	flat
kashoffi	(to) clean	kashofa	to be clean
ittiachi	(to) go (two only)	ilhkoli	(to) go (plural)
nuti	tooth/teeth	hopasa	chew
aiyvla	several arrives	ittvlachi	two arrives

**Activity:** VOCABULARY MEANING/FILL IN THE BLANKS

Students will review vocabulary words by reading sentences with clues and complete an activity that reviews subject pronouns.

**Closure:** Students will name all the subject pronouns from this lesson.
