Activity: VOCABULARY/SENTENCE WRITING/TRANSLATIONS Students will write the meaning of each Choctaw subject pronoun and translate Choctaw sentences to English.

Closure: Students will write the numbers I through 5 on a blank sheet of paper. Teacher will call Choctaw subject pronouns and students will write the English meanings.

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
