A COUNCIL RESOLUTION

TO APPROVE a Resolution supporting Canadian Valley Telephone in its application to the United States Department of Agriculture ("USDA") for a Rural Utility Service ReConnect 4 Program Grant.

WHEREAS, in accordance with Article IX, Section 4 of the Constitution of the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma, "The Tribal Council shall enact legislation, rules and regulations not inconsistent with this Constitution for the general good of the Choctaw Nation and for the administration and regulation of the affairs of the Choctaw Nation.";

WHEREAS, The USDA ReConnect Loan and Grant Program furnishes loans and grants to provide funds for the costs of construction, improvement, or acquisition of facilities and equipment needed to provide broadband service in eligible rural areas;

WHEREAS, Canadian Valley Telephone provides telecommunications services to rural communities in Eastern Oklahoma;

WHEREAS, Canadian Valley Telephone wishes to apply to the USDA for a Rural Utility Service ReConnect 4 Program Grant for the purpose of expanding broadband throughout the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma (the "Nation") generally, and more specifically in the Crowder area of Oklahoma;

WHEREAS, Canadian Valley Telephone commits to provide service over or on the tribal lands identified in the Proposed Funded Service Area ("PFSA") contained in their grant application for the betterment of the Nation's reservation and tribal members;

WHEREAS, the Nation wishes to support Canadian Valley Telephone's application to expand broadband throughout the Choctaw Nation; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has determined it is in the best interest of the Nation to support Canadian Valley Telephone's application to the USDA for a Rural Utility Service ReConnect 4 Program Grant in order to expand broadband services on the Choctaw Nation reservation.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma that this Resolution be cited as approval for supporting the application of Canadian Valley Telephone to the United States Department of Agriculture for a Rural Utility Service ReConnect 4 Program Grant.

Purpose/Need of Council Resolution: The purpose of this Resolution is to support Canadian Valley Telephone's application to the United States Department of Agriculture for a Rural Utility Service ReConnect 4 Program Grant. These grant funds are available to applicants for the costs of construction, improvement, or acquisition of facilities and equipment needed to provide broadband service in eligible rural areas.
