TO DISCLAIM ALL RIGHTS, TITLE, AND INTEREST IN SPECIFIC PROPERTY LOCATED IN PUSHMATAHA COUNTY

IN THE TRIBAL COUNCIL OF THE CHOCTAW NATION RONALD PERRY INTRODUCED THE FOLLOWING COUNCIL BILL

A COUNCIL BILL

TO DISCLAIM all rights, title, and interest the Choctaw Nation has in an unspecified two-acre tract of land reserved for a school in Pushmataha County, Oklahoma.

WHEREAS, in accordance with Article IX, Section 6 of the Constitution of the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma, the Choctaw Tribal Council (the "Council") shall make decisions pertaining to the acquisition, leasing, disposition and management of real property;

WHEREAS in accordance with Article VII, Section 1, of the Constitution of the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma, the Chief shall perform all duties appertaining to the office of chief executive. He shall sign official papers on behalf of the Nation;

WHEREAS the Choctaw and Chickasaw Nation issued Unallotted Land Deed number 17241 to Paul Witcomb conveying real property in Pushmataha County described as: The Northeast Quarter, Less Two (2) acres for school of Section Fourteen (14), Township Three (3) South, Range Sixteen (16) East; and (Subject Property).

WHEREAS the Unallotted Land Deed was executed by the Choctaw and Chickasaw Nation and approved by the Department of Interior. The Unallotted Land Deed was recorded in the County Clerk's Office of Pushmataha County on August 2nd, 1920;

WHEREAS a two-acre tract of land from the Subject Property was reserved by the U.S. to be used for a school. No school was built on the Subject Property and the Bureau of Indian Affairs has no patent in their records for the two-acre tract;

WHEREAS the two-acre tract was not described by metes and bounds and the exact location of the two-acre tract cannot be determined within the Subject Property;

WHEREAS the Subject Property is now owned by third-parties claiming and asserting full right, title, and interest to all of the Subject Property;

WHEREAS the Subject Property is not marketable and third parties cannot buy and sell tracts within the Subject Property because the location of the two-acre tract cannot be determined;

TO DISCLAIM ALL RIGHTS, TITLE, AND INTEREST IN SPECIFIC PROPERTY LOCATED IN PUSHMATAHA COUNTY

WHEREAS a disclaimer of all interest in the two-acre tract will remove the title defect and allow for the conveyance of certain tracts of the Subject Property; and

WHEREAS the Council finds it is in the best interest of the Nation to authorize the Chief of the Choctaw Nation to execute documents disclaiming any right, title, and interest to the two-acre tract located within the Subject Property.

THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED that the Tribal Council of the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma disclaims all rights, title, and interest in the Subject Property, including a two-acre tract of land previously excepted from the Subject Property for a school. See Exhibit A. The Subject Property is described as:

The Northeast Quarter, Less Two (2) acres for school of Section Fourteen (14), Township Three (3) South, Range Sixteen (16) East in Pushmataha County, Oklahoma.

BE IT FURTHER ENACTED by the Tribal Council that the Chief is hereby authorized to sign and execute the documentation necessary to carry out the purpose of this Bill and disavow the Nation's interest in the unspecified two-acres.

CERTIFICATION

I, the undersigned, as speaker of the Tribal Council of the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma, do hereby certify that the Tribal Council is composed of twelve (12) seats. Eight (8) members must be present to constitute a quorum. I further certify that twelve (12) members answered roll call and that a quorum was present at the Regular Session of the Tribal Council at Tuskahoma, Oklahoma on March 11, 2023. I further certify that the foregoing Council Bill CB-_____57__-23 was adopted at such meeting by the affirmative vote of twelve (12) members, zero (0) abstaining.

TO DISCLAIM ALL RIGHTS, TITLE, AND INTEREST IN SPECIFIC PROPERTY LOCATED IN PUSHMATAHA COUNTY

Purpose/Need of Council Bill: This bill authorizes the Chief of the Choctaw Nation to sign documentation disclaiming all rights, title, and interests to a two-acre tract of land held for the Choctaw Nation in trust in Pushmataha County. The Choctaw and Chickasaw Nation issued Unallotted Land Deed number 17241 to Paul Witcomb conveying real property in Pushmataha County (the "Subject Property.") A two-acre tract of land was reserved by the U.S within the Subject Property for the Choctaw and Chickasaw Nation to place a school. The two-acre tract of land was not described by metes and bounds and the location cannot be determined within the Subject Property. No school was ever built on the two-acre tract. Today, third-parties own the Subject Property. The Subject property is not marketable because the two-acre tract of land cannot be determined. This prevents third-parties from selling or buying any of the Subject Property. The Nation believes that disclaiming all interest in the two-acre tract will allow third-parties to buy and sell tracts within the Subject Property.
