IN THE TRIBAL COUNCIL OF THE CHOCTAW NATION RONALD PERRY INTRODUCED THE FOLLOWING COUNCIL BILL

A COUNCIL BILL

TO APPROVE the Native American Housing Assistance and Self-Determination Act of 1996 FY2024 Indian Housing Plan.

WHEREAS, in accordance with Article IX, Section 4 of the Constitution of the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma, "The Tribal Council shall enact legislation, rules and regulations not inconsistent with this Constitution for the general good of the Choctaw Nation and for the administration and regulation of the affairs of the Choctaw Nation":

WHEREAS, the Housing Authority of the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma (HACNO), the Tribally Designated Housing Entity (TDHE) for the Choctaw Nation, has prepared and submitted the Native American Housing Assistance and Self Determination Act of 1996 (NAHASDA) FY2024 Indian Housing Plan (IHP) Synopsis for approval. See Exhibit A;

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma (the "Council") must approve the NAHASDA FY2024 IHP before it can be submitted to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) for funding and implementation of the NAHASDA FY2024 allocation to Indian Tribes;

WHEREAS, IHP funds will meet the Nation's Strategic Goal to support service delivery to improve quality of life through providing affordable, reliable housing for tribal members; and

WHEREAS, the Council finds it is in the best interest of the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma to approve the NAHASDA FY2024 IHP for submittal to the HUD.

THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED by the Tribal Council of the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma that this Bill be cited as approval of the Native American Housing and Self Determination Act of 1996 FY2024 Indian Housing Plan.

BE IT FURTHER ENACTED by the Tribal Council of the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma that this Bill be cited as approval to submit this Indian Housing Plan to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development for compliance approval and funding for FY2024.

BE IT FURTHER ENACTED by the Tribal Council of the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma that this Bill be cited as an acknowledgement that the Chief of the Nation, or his designee, is authorized to prepare, execute, deliver and file any and all agreements, certificates, instruments and documents, in such form and with such terms and provisions as the Chief of the Nation, or his designee, may approve, and to take such other action as he, she or they may deem proper or appropriate, to carry out the intent and purposes of the foregoing enactments.

TO APPROVE THE NATIVE AMERICAN HOUSING ASSISTANCE AND SELF-DETERMINATION ACT OF 1996 INDIAN HOUSING PLAN FOR FY2024

Purpose/Need of Council Bill: This is the annual submittal of the Native American Housing Assistance and Self-Determination Act of 1996 (NAHASDA) Indian Housing Plan (IHP). This is a block grant for one year which includes eligible activities with number of members served for each service area. The IHP also includes an annual "block grant" amount which is estimated at \$13,439,758 for the year 2024. Due to the timing of the submittal, the IHP is designed to be "estimated" dollars, in anticipation of what the United States Congress will approve during 2024. Housing will operate during FY 2024 on Indian Housing Block Grant funds on hand (prior year grant dollars) for NAHASDA activities, which is typical, while waiting on the approval of the "block grant" portion to be approved. (SEE EXHIBIT A). IHP funds will meet the Nation's Strategic Goal to support service delivery to improve quality of life through providing affordable, reliable housing for tribal members.
