# TO APPROVE A PIPELINE EASEMENT IN FAVOR OF EXPLORER PIPELINE COMPANY ON LAND HELD BY THE USA IN TRUST FOR THE CHOCTAW AND CHICKASAW NATIONS IN LOVE COUNTY, OKLAHOMA

#### IN THE TRIBAL COUNCIL OF THE CHOCTAW NATION

#### RONALD PERRY INTRODUCED THE FOLLOWING COUNCIL BILL

#### A COUNCIL BILL

**TO APPROVE** a pipeline easement in favor of Explorer Pipeline Company on land held by the USA in trust for the Choctaw and Chickasaw Nations in Love County, Oklahoma.

WHEREAS, in accordance with Article VII, Section 1 of the Constitution of the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma, the Chief shall perform all duties pertaining to the Office of the Chief Executive. He shall sign official papers on behalf of the Nation;

WHEREAS, in accordance with Article IX, Section 6 of the Constitution of the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma, the Tribal Council (the "Council") shall make decisions pertaining to the acquisition, leasing, disposition, and management of tribal property;

WHEREAS, Explorer Pipeline Company is proposing a renewal of an existing eight-inch pipeline on a property held by the USA in Trust for the Choctaw and Chickasaw Nations, located in the W½ of Lot 1 and all of Lot 2 in Section 36, Township 9 South, Range 1 East, Indian Meridian, Love County, Oklahoma, containing 59.32 rods or 1.12 acres. See Exhibit A for Survey Plat and legal description;

**WHEREAS**, the payment will be \$14,830.00, which is \$250/rod. The Choctaw Nation's portion will be \$11,122.50 for their undivided <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub> interest in this tract;

**WHEREAS**, the easement shall be for a 20-year term and is for the purpose of continuing to operate and maintain the existing pipeline; and

**WHEREAS**, the Tribal Council has determined it is in the best interest of the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma to approve and grant the pipeline easement in favor of Explorer Pipeline Company.

**THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED** by the Tribal Council of the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma that this Bill be cited as approval of the proposed pipeline easement located in Section 36, Township 9 South, Range 1 East, Indian Meridian, Love County, OK, in favor of Explorer Pipeline Company, on land held by the USA in Trust for the Choctaw and Chickasaw Nations. See Exhibit B.

**BE IT FURTHER ENACTED** by the Tribal Council of the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma that this Bill be cited for approval of the payment of \$14,830.00 for a 20-year term, with the Choctaw Nation's portion being \$11,122.50 for its undivided <sup>3</sup>4 interest in the tract.

**BE IT FURTHER ENACTED** by the Tribal Council of the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma that this Bill be cited as an acknowledgement that the Chief of the Nation, or his designee, is authorized to prepare, execute, deliver and file any and all agreements, certificates, instruments and documents, in such form and with such terms and provisions as the Chief of the Nation, or his designee, may approve, and to take such other action as he, she or they may deem proper or appropriate, to carry out the intent and purposes of the foregoing enactments.



# **50' WIDE EASEMENT**

A portion of Tract 773 (also known as the W1/2 of lot 1 and all of lot 2) in section 36, township 9 south, range 1 east, Indian Meridian, County of Love, State of Oklahoma, Exhibit "A" being a 50 foot wide strip of land, the center line of which is more particularly described as follows:

BEGINNING AT A POINT on the east line of said W1/2 of Lot 1, South 00° 02' 33" West, a distance of 469.71 feet along said east line from the northeast corner of said W1/2 of Lot 1 (C-W-NW 1/64). Thence from the POINT OF BEGINNING,

- 1) South 37° 35' 33" West, 562.73 feet;
- 2) South 40° 39' 32" West, 246.72 feet;
- 3) South 67° 26' 36" West, 123.21 feet;
- 4) South 61° 12' 17" West, 46.18 feet, to a point on the south line of Tract 773, and the POINT OF TERMINATION, being South 00° 05' 15" East a distance of 1174.14 feet, from the north 1/16 corner of Sections 35 and 36.




