A COUNCIL BILL

TO APPROVE the application to the United States Department of Health and Human Services for the continuation of Elder Services funding from the Administration for Community Living/Administration on Aging Older Americans Act Title VI Nutrition, Supportive Service, and Caregiver Grants Parts A & C.

WHEREAS, the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma (the "Nation") is a federally recognized Tribe existing and acting pursuant to inherent and retained sovereignty;

WHEREAS, Article IX, Section 5 of the Constitution of the Nation grants the Tribal Council of the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma (the "Council") authority to enact legislation, rules, and regulations for the general good of the Nation and for the administration and regulation of the affairs of the Nation;

WHEREAS, funds for these grants will meet the Nation's Strategic Goal to support service delivery to improve quality of life;

WHEREAS, the Nation realizes the need to continue the delivery of nutrition, supportive, and caregiver services to elders and their caregivers; and

WHEREAS, funds from the United States Department of Health and Human Services Administration for Community Living/Administration on Aging Older Americans, will continue to help the Nation assist qualified elders 55 years of age and older, through the Choctaw Senior Nutrition Program, by providing nutritious meals at least once per week, supportive services, and caregiver services.

THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED by the Tribal Council of the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma that this Council Bill be cited as approval for application to the United States Department of Health and Human Services Administration for Community Living/Administration on Aging Older Americans Act Title VI grants (Parts A and C).
