WHEREAS, in accordance with Article VII, Section 2 of the Constitution of the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma (the "Nation"), the Chief has the power to "establish and appoint committees, members and delegates to represent the Choctaw Nation with the advice and consent of the Tribal Council.";

WHEREAS, Chief Gary Batton nominates Assistant Chief Jack Austin, Jr., for reappointment to the VA Advisory Committee on Tribal and Indian Affairs to represent the Nation, our Choctaw Veterans and other Native Americans who have served our country in military service;

WHEREAS, Assistant Chief Austin's dedication to service, education, experience and expertise make him a great fit for this role, as well as his ongoing commitment to serving the Nation and our veterans;

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the Nation supports efforts to build and grow our relationship with the U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs and Native veterans across the United States and Indian Country;

WHEREAS, Assistant Chief Austin is highly qualified and equipped to serve on this committee due to his commitment to serving our tribal members and his leadership as Chair of the VA Advisory Committee on Tribal and Indian Affairs. Assistant Chief Austin has the heart, business and governance acumen, and management and service expertise to provide strong guidance and advice as the VA serves Native veterans;

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has determined it is in the best interest of the Nation to support the nomination of Assistant Chief Jack Austin, Jr., for re-appointment to the U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs Advisory Committee on Tribal and Indian Affairs as a representative of the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma;
