#### IN THE TRIBAL COUNCIL OF THE CHOCTAW NATION

#### JAMES DRY INTRODUCED THE FOLLOWING COUNCIL BILL

#### A COUNCIL BILL

**TO APPROVE** the Choctaw Nation's participation in the U.S. Department of Transportation's (USDOT) Tribal Self-Governance Program.

WHEREAS, the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma (Choctaw Nation) has sovereign powers that are inherent in Tribal tradition, derived from a history of organized self-government since time immemorial, and recognized by treaties with the United States and in the Constitution of the United States;

WHEREAS, the Choctaw Nation has over 30 years of experience as a self-governance Tribe with the Departments of the Interior and Health and Human Services;

WHEREAS, the Choctaw Nation has very successfully operated the Indian Reservation Roads program for decades as well as many transit and other grants provided through the Department of Transportation;

WHEREAS, the USDOT self-governance authority will provide the Choctaw Nation with greater control, flexibility, and decision-making authority over funds used to carry out tribal transportation programs, functions, services, and activities in the Choctaw Nation reservation;

WHEREAS, the Choctaw Nation wishes to participate in the U.S. Department of Transportation's Tribal Self-Governance Program (DOTTSGP);

WHEREAS, the Choctaw Nation is eligible for the DOTTSGP and can detail its eligibility through conclusive evidence that demonstrates financial stability and financial management capability, that during the preceding 3 fiscal years, the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma had no uncorrected significant and material audit exceptions in the required annual audit of its self-governance funding agreements with any Federal agency;

WHEREAS, the Choctaw Nation can also demonstrate transportation program management capability, including the capability to manage and complete projects eligible under title 23 and chapter 53 of title 49 of the U.S. Code; and

WHEREAS, the Choctaw Nation can submit, upon reasonable request, any other evidence of program management capabilities, including non-transportation programs of similar complexity, size, administrative need, staffing requirement or budgets.

**THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma that this Resolution be cited as approval for supporting the participation in the U.S. Department of Transportation's Tribal Self-Governance Program.
