This year's General Election ballots included five (5) Constitutional Amendments, approved by Tribal Council in Council Bill-27-25. The following ballot titles were provided to the Election Board to appear on the ballot as such:

Proposition Number: 2025 001

This proposal amends Article I, Section 2 of the Choctaw Constitution. It removes the description of the boundaries of the Choctaw Nation Reservation. Those boundaries are based on a map that is not available. The proposed description of the boundaries is clearer and more readable. It is based on federal statutes and treaties.

Shall the proposed amendment to the Constitution of the Choctaw Nation be approved?

A "YES" vote is a vote in favor of the proposed amendment. A "NO" vote is a vote against the proposed amendment.

Proposition Number: 2025 002

This proposal amends Article IV, Section 1 of the Choctaw Constitution by removing the following language: "the State of Oklahoma, the United States of America or under any Act of the Congress of the United States." Removing this language strengthens the Nation's sovereignty by enabling the Choctaw Nation to be ruled by its own laws. This proposal also amends the Article XVII Oath of Office by removing "the State of Oklahoma, and the United States of America" from the Oath of Office to be uniform and further strengthen the Nation's ability to make, amend, and be governed by its own laws.

Shall the proposed amendment to the Constitution of the Choctaw Nation be approved?

Proposition Number: 2025 003

This proposal amends Article VIII, Section 2 of the Choctaw Constitution by removing the individual land descriptions for the twelve (12) Districts within the Choctaw Nation Reservation boundaries. The current description of the twelve (12) Districts and land they embrace is no longer accurate due to reapportionment by Tribal Council, which is within Tribal Council's power. Removing the individual land descriptions for each District and providing the Tribal Council's general authority to determine the area each District embraces by making these amendments makes the Choctaw Constitution more accurate and clearer.

Proposition Number: 2025 004

This proposal amends Article VIII, Section 5 of the Choctaw Constitution by changing "Tuskahoma" to its correct spelling of "Tvshka Homma." This amendment exercises sovereignty and protects and promotes Choctaw Culture by correctly referring to the Capitol of the Choctaw Nation by its Choctaw name.

Shall the proposed amendment to the Constitution of the Choctaw Nation be approved?

Proposition Number: 2025 005

This proposal amends Article XVIII, Section 2 of the Choctaw Constitution by removing the requirement of approval by the Secretary of the Interior for Amendments to the Choctaw Constitution. Removing this Secretary of the Interior approval requirement from the Choctaw Constitution enhances the Nation's sovereignty by removing federal oversight and enables the Choctaw Nation to amend the Choctaw Constitution without federal interference or involvement.
