ANNUAL CHOCTAW NATION LIVESTOCK SHOW

ELIGIBILITY:

Must be a 4-H or FFA member.

Must still be in high school (cannot have graduated from high school).

Must be a student between 3rd and 12th grade.

Must have a Certificate Degree of Indian Blood (CDIB).

Must be no older than age 19 on the day of the show.

There are NO Boundary Guidelines again this year, so participants DO NOT have to live or go to school within the 10.5 counties of the Choctaw Nation.

GENERAL RULES & REGULATIONS

- 1. Entry fee is \$10.00 per head; late fee is \$25.00 (after January 25). Up to three (3) entries per division (swine-goats-sheep-heifers-steers).
- 2. Wood chips or shavings only shall be used for bedding. (NO HAY OR STRAW) Participants must bring their own shavings.
 - Durant show No Shavings in Cattle Barn
- 3. Each school will be responsible for monitoring their students and following their eligibility rules for participating in activities.
- 4. A photo area will be set-up for all breed, reserve breed and grand champions.
- 5. All animals must be owned by 4-H or FFA exhibitor at least 60 days prior to show.
- 6. No animal can be shown at both shows.

Swine Show:

- 1. Breeds: Berkshire, Chester, Duroc, Hampshire, Hereford, Poland, Spot, Yorkshire, and Cross Breed.
- 2. Exhibitors are responsible for weighing their swine and turning in the weight cards by 8:30 AM on the day of the show. There will be a 10-pound weigh back from the weighin card. Minimum weight of swine is 120 lbs. on card and Maximum weight of swine is 280 lbs. on card.
- 3. Health certificates or signed statement for pseudorabies will be required for all swine.
- 4. Barrows and gilts are eligible. (NO BOARS)
- 5. It is the exhibitors' responsibility to bring panels to separate their pens.
- 6. Clipping of swine will not be permitted on the grounds.
- 7. Swine will be shown with no paints or powders.

Doe Show:

- 1. Does will be shown by weight only.
- 2. Exhibitors are responsible for weighing their Does and turning in the weight cards by 2:00 pm = Wilburton Show & 8:30 am = Durant Show. There will be a 5-pound weigh back from the weigh-in card. Minimum weight of doe is 30 lbs. on card and No Maximum weight.
- 3. All does must be shown with a choke chain, collar or halter.
- 4. All horns must be tipped/rounded.

Wether Show:

- 1. Wethers will be shown by weight only.
- 2. Exhibitors are responsible for weighing their Wethers and turning in the weight cards by 2:00 pm = Wilburton Show & 10:00 am = Durant Show. There will be a 5-pound weigh back from the weigh-in card. Minimum weight of wether is 30 lbs. on card and No Maximum weight.
- 3. No bucks are allowed to show.

- 4. All wethers must be shown with a choke chain, collar or halter. Sheep style bracing with all four hooves on the ground is allowed.
- 5. Recommended wethers be sheared to a maximum of 3/8-inch residual hair length.
- 6. All horns must be tipped/rounded.
- 7. Whether dams will be allowed to show in the Wether Show.

Lamb Show:

- 1. Lambs will be shown by weight only.
- 2. Exhibitors are responsible for weighing their lambs and turning in the weight cards by 3:00 pm = Wilburton Show & 11:00 am = Durant show. There will be a 5-pound weigh back from the weigh-in card. There will be No Minimum weight or Maximum weight for the sheep.
- 3. It is recommended that all sheep shown must have a complete body slick sheared with no more than 10 days of growth and not have more than ½ inch of wool at the time of the show.
- 4. Lambs must be shown without paint.

Heifer Show:

1. Heifers will be divided into 4 Divisions:

AOB Division

For any breeds not listed in the other 3 divisions. To include all heifers without registration papers.

- 2. Heifers in the English Division, Continental Division and Brahman Influence Division must have Registration Papers with date of birth shown. These divisions will be broken into classes by age. (Maximum age 24 months)
- 3. Heifers in the AOB Division will be broken into classes by weight. Beef Director will weigh the AOB Heifers from 8:00 am to 10:00 am, on the day of the show.
- 4. Blow & Show Only.

Steer Show:

1. Steers will be divided into 4 Divisions:
