**IN THE TRIBAL COUNCIL OF THE CHOCTAW NATION**

**JAMES DRY INTRODUCED THE FOLLOWING COUNCIL BILL**

---

**A COUNCIL BILL**

**TO APPROVE** and ratify contributions to the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma's Sustainability and Permanent Fund.

**WHEREAS**, in accordance with Article IX, Section 6 of the Constitution of The Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma (the "Nation"), the Tribal Council of the Nation (the "Council") shall make decisions pertaining to the acquisition, leasing, disposition and management of tribal property;

**WHEREAS**, the Nation invests in a Sustainability Fund (herein so called) and a Permanent Fund (collectively, along with the Sustainability Fund, the "Funds"), directly and through wholly-owned subsidiaries, to ensure the future sustainability of the Nation's operations and ability to provide programs to Tribal members; and

**WHEREAS**, the Council believes it is in the best interest of the Nation to invest in the Funds and that any interest, distributions, and profits made through the Funds may be retained and/or reinvested through the Funds.

**THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED** by the Council that this Bill be cited as approval of the Funds and ratification of any prior investments in the Funds.

**BE IT FURTHER ENACTED** by the Council that the funds authorized herein shall be invested and may be retained and/or reinvested within the Fund for the purposes of strengthening the fiscal sustainability of the Nation and supporting the Nation's continued ability to fund the Nation's operations and provide services and programs to Tribal members.

**BE IT FURTHER ENACTED** by the Council that this Bill be cited as approval that any interest, distributions, and profits made through the Funds may be retained and/or reinvested within such Funds, as determined by the Chief of the Nation and/or his designee, in his/their reasonable discretion.


**BE IT FURTHER ENACTED** by the Council that this Bill be cited as approval to invest an additional Seventy Million Dollars (\$70,000,000) in the Sustainability Fund.

**BE IT FURTHER ENACTED** by the Council that this Bill be cited as approval that such additional funding into the Sustainability Fund shall come from unrestricted funds.


