

TO AMEND CB-33-26

IN THE TRIBAL COUNCIL OF THE CHOCTAW NATION

JAMES DRY INTRODUCED THE FOLLOWING BILL

A COUNCIL BILL

TO APPROVE an amendment to CB-33-26, approving a grant of right-of-way for a pipeline easement, in favor of ET Gathering & Processing, LLC, an affiliate of Enable Midstream Partners, L.P., on land held by the USA in Trust for the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma in Pittsburg County, Oklahoma.

WHEREAS, in accordance with Article VII, Section 1 of the Constitution of the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma (the "Nation"), the Chief shall perform all duties pertaining to the Office of the Chief Executive. He shall sign official papers on behalf of the Nation;

WHEREAS, in accordance with Article IX, Section 6 of the Constitution of the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma, the Tribal Council (the "Council") shall make decisions pertaining to the acquisition, leasing, disposition, and management of tribal property;

WHEREAS, the Council CB-33-26 TO APPROVE A GRANT OF RIGHT-OF-WAY FOR A PIPELINE EASEMENT, IN FAVOR OF ET GATHERING & PROCESSING, LLC, ON LAND HELD BY THE USA IN TRUST FOR THE CHOCTAW NATION OF OKLAHOMA IN PITTSBURG COUNTY, OKLAHOMA, a bill approving a grant of a official right-of-way to an existing pipeline easement at Jones Academy for a perpetual term. *See Exhibit A*;

WHEREAS, CB-33-26 stated the easement is a 6-inch pipeline located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ and the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 28, Township 5 North, Range 17 East, Pittsburg County;

WHEREAS, the Nation now proposes to amend CB-33-26 to state the easement is located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ and SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 28, Township 5 North, Range 17 East, Pittsburg County. This legal description matches the legal description stated in the survey. *See Exhibit B*; and

WHEREAS, the Council has determined it is in the best interest of the Nation to approve the amendment to CB-33-26 to correctly describe the legal description that is stated in the survey.

THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED by the Council that this Bill be cited as approval to amend CB-33-26 so that the legal description of the easement is corrected to the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ and SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 28, Township 5 North, Range 17 East, Pittsburg County.

BE IT FURTHER ENACTED by the Council that, this Bill be cited as an acknowledgement that the Chief of the Nation, or his designee, is authorized to prepare, execute, deliver and file any and all agreements, certificates, instruments and documents, in such form and with such terms and provisions as the Chief of the Nation, or his designee, may approve, and to take such other action as he, she or they may deem proper or appropriate, to carry out the intent and purposes of this Bill and CB-33-26, as amended.

AMENDMENT TO CB-33-26

TO APPROVE AN AMENDMENT TO A GRANT OF RIGHT-OF-WAY FOR A PIPELINE EASEMENT, IN FAVOR OF ET GATHERING & PROCESSING, LLC, ON LAND HELD BY THE USA IN TRUST FOR THE CHOCTAW NATION OF OKLAHOMA IN PITTSBURG COUNTY, OKLAHOMA


BE IT FURTHER ENACTED by the Council that any language in CB-22-26 that is inconsistent with this amendment is hereby superseded and shall be interpreted in a manner consistent with this Bill.

BE IT FURTHER ENACTED by the Council that, except as expressly amended herein, all remaining provisions of CB-33-26 shall remain in full force and effect.

CERTIFICATION

I, the undersigned, as Speaker of the Tribal Council of the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma, do hereby certify that the Tribal Council is composed of twelve (12) seats. Eight (8) members must be present to constitute a quorum. I further certify that twelve (12) members answered roll call and that a quorum was present at the Regular Session of the Tribal Council at Tvshka Homma, Oklahoma, on June 13, 2026. I further certify that the foregoing Council Bill CB- 62 -26 was adopted at such meeting by the affirmative vote of twelve (12) members, zero (0) negative votes, and zero (0) abstaining.
