ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

(Full eligibility requirements will be provided upon submission of the inquiry form)

Participating organizations must:

- ◆ Be located within the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma Reservation.
- ◆ Be a nonprofit, community group, local municipality, school, or a state/federal recognized organization.
- ◆ Demonstrate a direct, positive impact for the communities it is intended to serve within the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma Reservation.
- ◆ Demonstrate their organizational capacity to effectively manage any funding and sustain project objectives.
