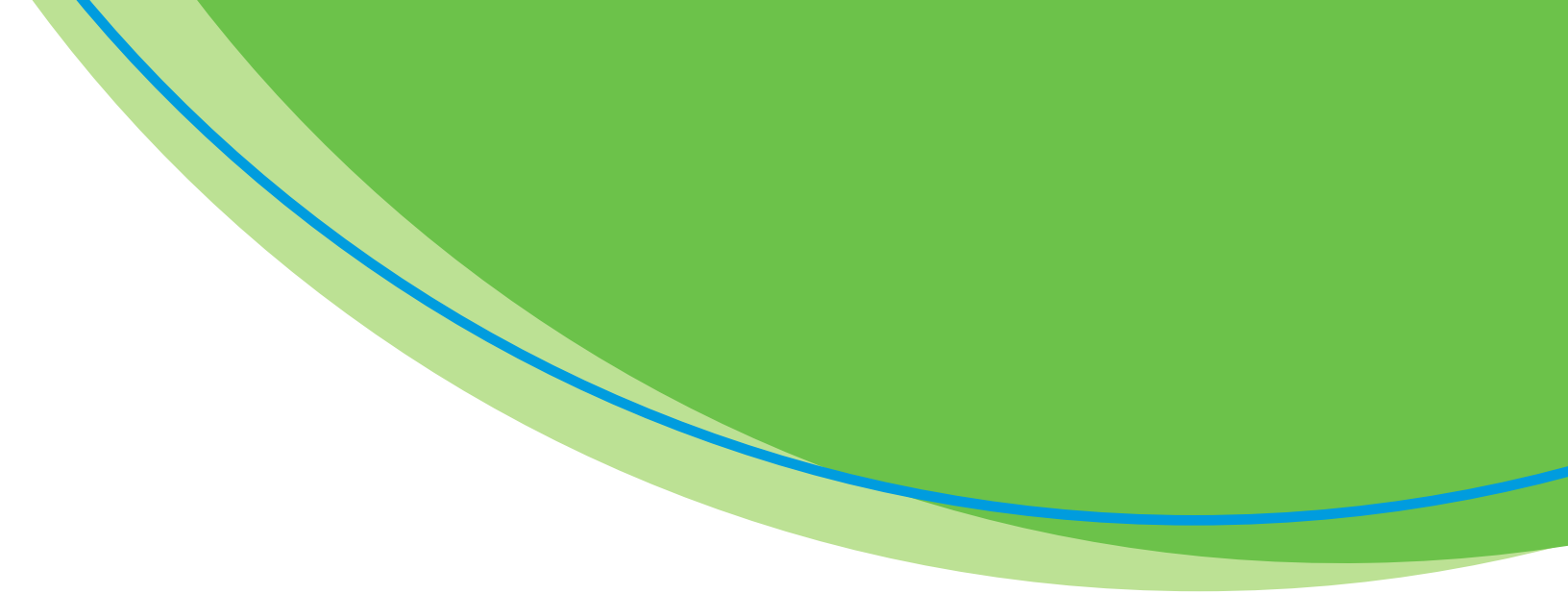




McGIRT IMPACT

Second Judicial Center •••••

CNO opened its second Judicial Center in McAlester, OK, to improve access to justice for residents in the reservation’s northern counties. Over 40 percent of cases in the Choctaw Nation District Court originate from the reservation’s northern counties, making the McAlester courthouse essential for expanding access and strengthening our court system. The Judicial Branch maintains an online pleading filing system and three physical locations for accepting court filings.

Cross Deputization Agreements •••••

The Choctaw Nation and the Fort Smith Police Department (FSPD) signed Arkansas’s first tribal law enforcement agreement. This cross-deputization agreement adds to over 75 similar agreements in Oklahoma, enhancing public safety and law enforcement coverage within the Choctaw Nation’s reservation.

The Ahni Center •••••

Since opening in 2023, The Ahni Center—the first tribal Family Justice Center of its kind in Oklahoma’s Indian Country—has served approximately 450 victims. The center provides forensic interviews, Sexual Assault Nursing Exams for adults and children, and therapy for victims of all ages. “Ahni” means “hope” in the Choctaw language.
