

TO APPROVE THE DISPOSAL OF SURPLUS CAPITAL ASSETS - VEHICLES

IN THE TRIBAL COUNCIL OF THE CHOCTAW NATION

JAMES DRY INTRODUCED THE FOLLOWING COUNCIL BILL

A COUNCIL BILL

TO APPROVE the disposal of vehicles with a cost of \$1,161,019.77, a net book value of \$80,995.75 and a fair-market value of \$323,333.61, including all listed inventory as attached in Exhibit A.

WHEREAS, in accordance with Article IX, Section 6 of the Constitution of the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma: "The Choctaw Tribal Council shall make decisions pertaining to the acquisition, leasing, disposition and management of tribal property";

WHEREAS, the Choctaw Nation (the "Nation") has surplus inventory vehicles that need to be disposed of in accordance with the Fixed Asset Management Policy and Procedure;

WHEREAS, the Nation also have vehicles that are broken, obsolete, have exceeded their useful life, or simply no longer useful;

WHEREAS, the Fixed Assets Department desires to dispose of said excess vehicles or vehicles no longer useful in the most cost-effective manner possible;

WHEREAS, the net proceeds of the sale of the vehicles shall be deposited into the Internal Services Leasing Fund or returned to the federal agency as required in the applicable terms of the federal award(s); and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has determined it is in the best interest of the Nation to approve of the disposal of vehicles listed in Exhibit A and approve the net proceeds of the sale of the vehicles be returned to the program or returned to the federal agency as required in the applicable federal award document.

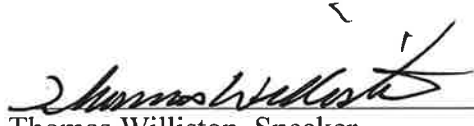
THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED by the Tribal Council of the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma that this Bill be cited as approval for the Fixed Assets Department to dispose of all vehicles listed in Exhibit A, in the most cost-effective manner possible and in accordance with Choctaw Nation Fixed Asset Management Policy and Procedure.

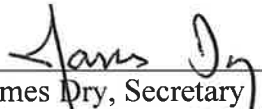
BE IT FURTHER ENACTED by the Tribal Council of the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma that net proceeds of the sale of the vehicles be returned to the program or returned to the federal agency as required in the applicable terms of the federal award(s).
