

**TO APPROVE THE APPLICATION TO THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF
HOUSING AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT FOR THE TRIBAL HOUSING AND
URBAN DEVELOPMENT-VETERANS AFFAIRS SUPPORTIVE HOUSING (TRIBAL
HUD-VASH) RENEWAL GRANT**

IN THE TRIBAL COUNCIL OF THE CHOCTAW NATION

JAMES DRY INTRODUCED THE FOLLOWING COUNCIL BILL

A COUNCIL BILL

TO APPROVE the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development Tribal Housing and Urban Development-Veterans Affairs Supportive Housing (Tribal HUD-VASH) Renewal Grant Application.

WHEREAS, the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma (the “Nation”) authorizes the Housing Authority of the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma (“HACNO”) to apply, on behalf of the Nation, for funding through the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development Tribal Housing and Urban Development-Veterans Affairs Supportive Housing (Tribal HUD-VASH) Renewal Grant Program; and

WHEREAS, the Nation authorizes HACNO to apply for the Tribal HUD-VASH Renewal Grant for a maximum award amount of rental assistance and administrative fees under the program guidelines, to be determined by the agency, with no tribal match commitment; and

WHEREAS, if awarded, HACNO will be responsible for compliantly administering the Tribal HUD-VASH program for the purpose of meeting the Nation's Strategic Goal to empower people by providing subsidized rental assistance to Native American Veterans in need of supportive services and are homeless or at risk of being homeless.

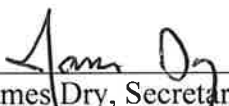
THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED by the Tribal Council of the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma that this Bill be cited as authorization for the Housing Authority of the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma to apply to the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development Tribal Housing and Urban Development-Veterans Affairs Supportive Housing (Tribal HUD-VASH) Renewal Grant Application for a maximum federal award to be determined by the agency with no Tribal Match.

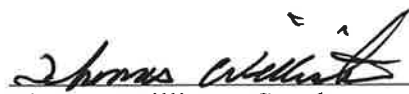
BE IT FURTHER ENACTED by the Council that this Bill be cited as an acknowledgement that the Chief of the Nation, or his designee, is authorized to prepare, execute, deliver and file any and all agreements, certificates, instruments and documents, in such form and with such terms and provisions as the Chief of the Nation, or his designee, may approve, and to take such other action as he, she or they may deem proper or appropriate, to carry out the intent and purposes of the foregoing enactments.

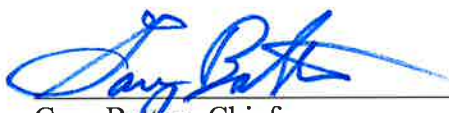
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CERTIFICATION
