

**TO APPROVE A SERVICE LINE AGREEMENT, IN FAVOR OF ARKANSAS VALLEY
ELECTRIC COOPERATIVE, ITS SUCCESSORS AND ASSIGNS, SPECIFICALLY
WAVE RURAL CONNECT**

IN THE TRIBAL COUNCIL OF THE CHOCTAW NATION OF OKLAHOMA

JAMES DRY INTRODUCED THE FOLLOWING COUNCIL BILL

A COUNCIL BILL

TO APPROVE a service line agreement, in favor of Arkansas Valley Electric Cooperative, its successors and assigns, specifically Wave Rural Connect, on land held by the USA in Trust for the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma (the "Nation") in Leflore County, Oklahoma;

WHEREAS, in accordance with Article VII, Section 1 of the Constitution of the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma, "the Chief shall perform all duties appertaining to the office of the Chief Executive. He shall sign official papers on behalf of the Nation";

WHEREAS, in accordance with Article IX, Section 6 of the Constitution of the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma, the Tribal Council of the Nation (the "Council") "shall make decisions pertaining to the acquisition, leasing, disposition and management of tribal property";

WHEREAS, Arkansas Valley Electric Cooperative is requesting to place and operate 3 phase underground lines and fiber optic cables necessary for its distribution of electric service, and for Wave Rural Connect to provide broadband service to the Nation. This new line placement is to facilitate and move old line due to the Pocola Casino & Resort expansion project, located in the S½ SW¼ of Section 34, Township 10 North, Range 27 East, Leflore County;

WHEREAS, the payment will be \$0.00;

WHEREAS, the service line shall be for a perpetual term, so long as it is used for its intended purpose; and

WHEREAS, the Council has determined it is in the best interest of the Nation to grant this service line agreement in favor of Arkansas Valley Electric Cooperative, its successors and assigns, specifically Wave Rural Connect.

THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED by the Council that this Bill be cited as approval of the Service Line Agreement, in favor of Arkansas Valley Electric Cooperative, its successors and assigns, specifically Wave Rural Connect, on land held by the USA in Trust for the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma in Leflore County, Oklahoma.

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BE IT FURTHER ENACTED by the Council that this Bill be cited as approval of the acceptance of the service line agreement for a payment of \$0.00 for a perpetual term, so long as the service line is used for its intended purpose of providing service to property owned by the Nation.

BE IT FURTHER ENACTED by the Council that this Bill be cited as an acknowledgment that the Chief of the Nation, or his designee, is authorized to prepare, execute, deliver, and file any and all agreements, certificates, instruments, and documents, in such form and with such terms and provisions as the Chief of the Nation, or his designee, may approve, and to take such other action as he, she, or they may deem proper or appropriate, to carry out the intent and purposes of the foregoing enactments.

CERTIFICATION

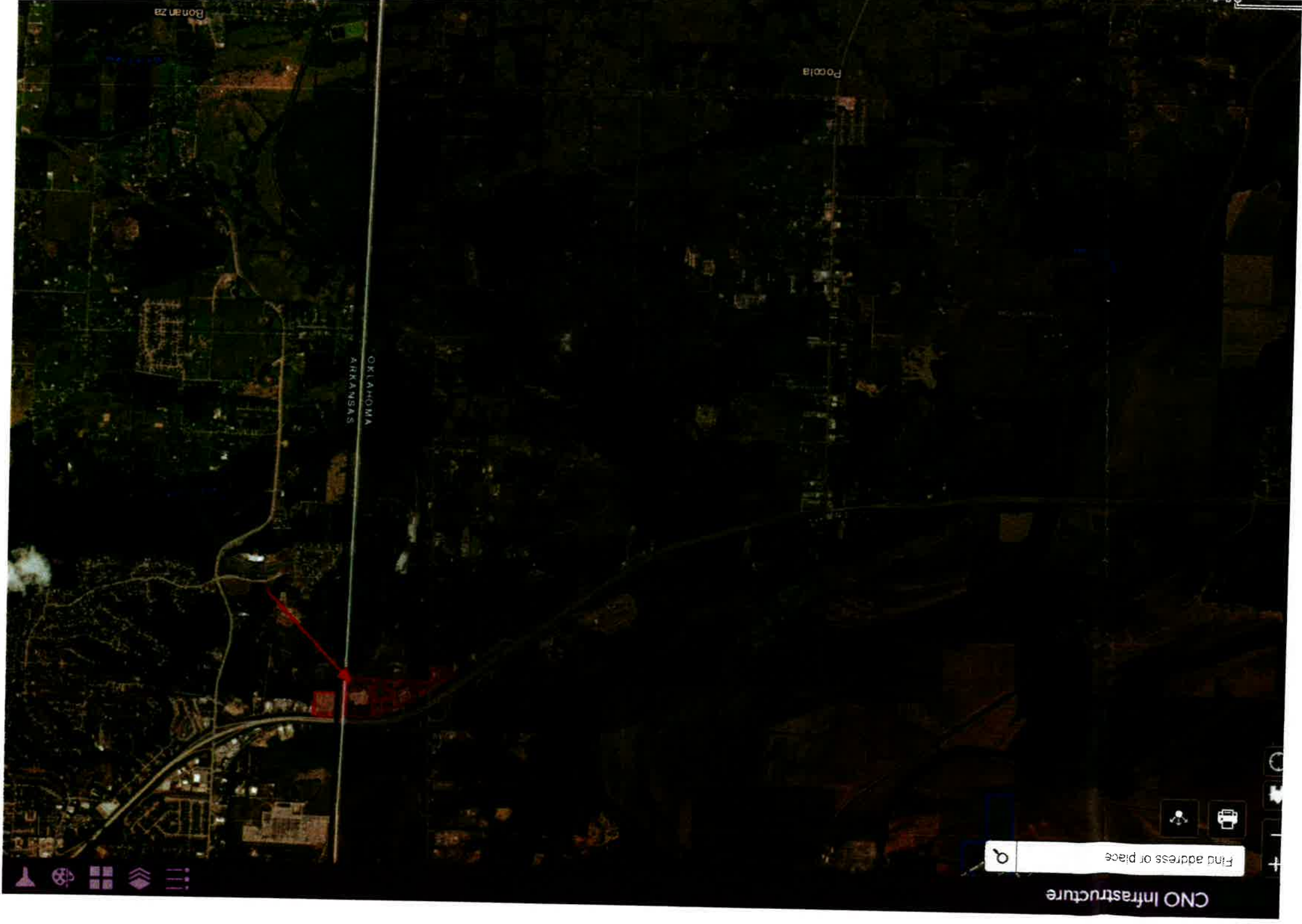
